Bike for Bibles "Tour de Youth" rides are a fund raising initiative of the Bible Society. They are organised and supervised by experienced cyclists. Tour de Youth rides are designed to provide a safe holiday cycling adventure for high school aged teenagers.

Our goal is to raise funds to provide materials for literacy in different projects set up by the Bible Society. Participants are required to collect tax-deductible donations from family, friends, school mates and neighbours. Other forms of fund raising such as selling chocolates, car washes, sausage sizzles and putting on plays are other means by which teens have fund-raised for the Tour de Youth.

Most of this year's ride will be on sealed roads though there are some gravel surfaces. Riders are recommended to use Mountain bikes for the ride.

The team will be starting their ride from Bunbury. Plan is to commence riding on the Sunday morning.

Riding an average of 70km per day, the team will stay overnight at various halls and churches, passing through Capel, Busselton, Cowaramup, Margaret River, Augusta and Nannup. The ride will be on the Bussell Highway to Capel/Busselton and on the Vasse and Brockman Highways around Nannup. We travel on the back roads around Margaret River and Augusta. We finish in Busselton on Thursday and return to Bunbury Friday morning.
